Subject: Subject Combination for B.A. Course.

Respected Sir,

It is mentioned under the above subject that, from the upcoming academic session 2026–27, the B.A. programme is proposed to be conducted with 10 optional subjects, out of which 5 are practical subjects (Geography, Drawing, Music, Physical Education & Yoga) and 5 are theoretical subjects (Economics, History, Public Administration, Hindi and English Literature). The three subject combinations should be formed in such a way that the maximum number of practical subjects in any one combination does not exceed two.
